

Research Guides: Online help on a range o research, clinical, and education topics, developed by Yale librarians. library.medicine.yale.edu/guides


Tutorials: Video tutorials on literature searching, citation management, evidence-based practice, research impact, and more. library.medicine.yale.edu/tutorials

RESEARCH SERVICES

Bioinformatics Support: Librarians specializing in bioinformatics offer research consultations, help using databases and sotware, and related training.

Statistics & GIS: Statistical and GIS consultants come weekly to the library to offer research guidance and help with statistics software.

Research Data Consultations: Learn about data management solutions, sharing data and research software, finding research data, and identifying strategies for working with and visualizing large data resources.
