



TRAINING & GUIDES

RESEARCH SERVICES

Bioinformatics Support: Librarians specializing in bioinformatics offer research consultations, help using databases and software, and related training.

Statistics & GIS: Statistical and GIS consultants come weekly to the library to offer research guidance and help with statistics software.

GETTING ACCESS TO RESOURCES FOR YNHH AFFILIATES

Yale University Library ID Card: Borrow books from all 15 libraries in the Yale University Library System with a library ID card. Apply at the Medical Library.

COLLECTIONS

Databases: The Medical Library subscribes to many top medical databases, including Ovid, Scopus, and Web of Science.

E-Journals and E-Books: The Medical Library subscribes to many top medical e-journals and e-books.

Mobile apps: CWML provides a suite of medicalrelated mobile applications for use by Yale University and Yale New Haven Hospital affiliates, including UpToDate and VisualDx.

SPECIAL COLLECTIONS

Cushing Center: The Cushing Center holds the Cushing Brain Tumor Registry, an archival collection of over 2,200 case studies which includes human whole brain specimens, tumor specimens, microscopic slides, notes, journal excerpts and over 15,000 photographic negatives dating from the late 1800's to 1936.
