Resource Spotlight

The **TRIP** (Turning Research Into Practice) database is an evidence-based medical search engine designed to help healthcare professionals find high-quality clinical research to inform patient care decisions. It curates and indexes a wide range of literature, including clinical guidelines, systematic reviews, and primary research studies.

The AskTRIP feature is an advanced query tool within the database that allows users to ask complex clinical questions in natural language and receive a summary of the current research within the database with references.

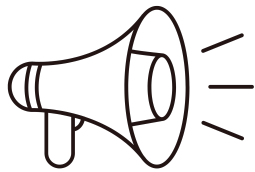
