This resource provides concise clinical information on hundreds of conditions, helping you make informed decisions efficiently.

### **NatMed Pro**

Information about natural medicines, including herbs, dietary supplements, sports supplements, minerals, and vitamins.

### **TRIP Pro**

Turning Research into Practice simultaneously searches evidence-based sources of systematic reviews, practice guidelines, and critically appraised
